

LANDINGS DOG PARK RULES & REGULATION

The following is designed to ensure that you and your dog will have a pleasant experience.

- Dogs must be registered at The Landings Association Administration Office.
- Visiting dogs do not need to be registered; however, they must be accompanied by a Landings resident (host) as well as their owner and abide by all rules, regulations and postings for The Landings Dog Park.
- Owners of visiting dogs are liable for any aggressive behavior, damages, vet bills, etc.
- Owners must present proof of vaccination at the time of registration. While County regulations require only rabies immunization, dogs must also be vaccinated for Bordatella (kennel cough), and DHLPP/Parvo in order to use the Landings Dog park.
- Puppies under four months of age are not permitted to use the Park. They are at risk for infection, as immune systems are not fully mature.
- Dogs must be leashed outside the Park. This includes walking to and from the Park and in the parking lot.
- Always remain in control and keep your dog in sight.
- Owners must bring their own bags to clean up immediately after their dog. Disposal receptacles are provided.

How to Enter the Park

- Do not open the outside gate if the inside gate is open.
- Remove your dog's leash inside the double gated holding area. Be sure the gate area is not congested with excited dogs ready to pounce as your dog enters. Upon entering, close the gate and move your dog away from the entrance.
- Do not leave your dog's leash on while in the park unless you are uncertain as to your dog's initial behavior. If so, you might want to leave a short leash attached to grab quickly if needed.

Current Dog Park Etiquette

- All dogs benefit from guidance and structure. Dog owners are urged to provide basic obedience training, a must for a safe, well socialized, and happy dog.
- Please do not bring people food/ dog treats. The only exception is during training sessions.
- Owners must never leave their dogs unattended and must always keep their dogs in sight .
- The small Dog Park area is reserved for dogs 20 pounds or less when present.
- Owners are required to clean up after their dogs immediately and to fill any holes dug.
- Only three dogs per person are allowed at the same time.
- No child under the age of 12 may supervise a dog
- No child under the age of 6 is permitted in the Park
- No strollers, carriages, bicycles, glass containers, children's toys, food, or treats are permitted in the Park.
- Do not leave dog toys, balls, and/or other instruments in the Dog Park. If you see a loose toy, ball, and /or instrument, please remove it as soon as possible.
- Female dogs while in heat are not allowed in the Park.
- Dogs exhibiting aggressive behavior are not to be moved to another area if the Park and are to leave if aggressive behavior continues.
- Dogs showing repeated aggression cannot use the Park
- Dog fights should be reported to Landings Security.
- Failure to abide by these rules is cause for suspension of Park Permit.
